

The Clemons Family Timeline Moments

First to Arrive in New England (Massachusetts Bay Colony) was Augustine Clement (b: 1604, Reading, Berkshire, England, d: 1674, Dorchester, MA).

First to be born in New England (Massachusetts Bay Colony) was Samuel Clement(ce), Sr. (b: 1635, Dorchester, MA, d: 1678, Dorchester, MA) son of Augustine Clement (b: 1604, Reading, England, d: 1674, Norfolk, MA).

First to Spell the family name as "Clemons" was Phillip Clemons, Sr. (b: 1705, Salem, MA, d: 1763, Salem, MA) son of Samuel Clement(ce) (b: 1660, Middlesex, MA; d: unknown).

Family Moved From MA to NY between 1758 and 1808 by Joseph Clemons (b: 1728, Dudley, MA, d: 1808, Whitehall, NY)?

Jonathan Clemons I, son of Joseph Clemons (b: 1728, Dudley, MA, d: 1808, Whitehall, NY) moved the family to Whitehall, NY area to possibly claim lands due to him as a Revolutionary War veteran.

Patriarch Jonathan Clemons I dies (b: 1758, MA, d: 1828, Whitehall, NY).

Family Moved From Whitehall, NY to Leoni, MI in 1834-5 by Jonathan Clemons II (b: 1784, Whitehall, NY, d: 1869, Leoni, Jackson County, MI) & Lucy Spink Clemons (b: 1771, d: 1850, Leoni, MI).
